

WHAT DID LLSA ACCOMPLISH IN 2017? A lot... and we could not have done it without the help of many Leonard Lake volunteers, so THANK YOU sincerely! Here's a slice of what kept us and volunteers busy...













We communicated! 27 EBLASTS and informational emails... developed a "Welcome to Leonard Lake Kit with many tips for a healthy lake...organized "Trade Secrets", a summer on-the-water social event...led the clean up for our slice of Hwy 118 as part of Muskoka community clean up day...led a LL Thanksgiving Food Drive resulting in a car load of donations...participated in relevant environmental conferences like "50 Shades of Green"...met with agencies such as Muskoka Lakes Association and the Watershed Council work group on issues such as water quality and algae...opposed Official Plan Amendment 45 Revised Water Quality Policy for Muskoka through several written and in-person presentations...conducted regular water sampling and testing for e-coli, phosphorus and benthic critters as part of the Lake Partner Program...started an "Eyes on the Lake" watch that resulted in 15 reports from residents on algae sightings that were followed up on...filed a government access to information request to obtain every document available on Leonard Lake...undertook a "lake health status" project by recruiting professional and technical expertise to provide research and guidance, conducting an extensive water testing initiative from May to October and commissioning 3 studies to inform all of us on LL and all government levels on the current health status of

Leonard Lake...advocated on behalf of Leonard Lake to council, mayor, Township of Muskoka Lakes and District Municipality of Muskoka Lakes through correspondence and participating in public and private meetings on topics such as protecting Leonard Lake waters, waterfront development and the proposed changes to the Official Plan...participated in invasive species watch program...connected with key groups such as FOCA and the Muskoka Lakes Association...organized the LLSA annual general meeting including keynote speakers, budget, handouts, membership and updates...LLSA board meets approximately monthly throughout the year, both in person and through conference calls to plan, share information and work on joint projects.

AND HOW DID WE PAY FOR ALL OF THAT ACTIVITY?

2017 LLSA membership dues paid for the lion's share of regular activities last year in addition to general operating expenses such as insurance and audio conferencing. The exception was the "lake health status" project mentioned above that LLSA was able to undertaken as a special initiative thanks to the generous donations of three Leonard Lake families. This extensive body of work was viewed as essential for Leonard Lake as a baseline of lake health.
