Just a reminder about the Thanksgiving food drive...

You can drop your donations off at Gord and Jennifer Roberts' cottage at 1033-1 Alice Avenue, Leonard Lake Road 1 OR at the Roberts' dock by boat in Rainbow Bay (see red mark on map below). Your drop off to the Roberts is preferred, given potential complications with weather and lake travel in October.

If drop off is not possible, your contribution is still welcomed. By noon on Tuesday, October 10th place food donations in a sealed plastic bag at the end of your dock (or shore, if your dock is out) for pickup.

Suggested items for donation:

Unopened and unexpired food packages and cans - food banks can't re-distribute open packages or food that has passed expiry date

Canned food (especially canned meat). Cans with pull-tabs are helpful too and essential for some

recipients.

Unopened jars, and dried foods.

Snacks and lunch items for kids.

Pantry staples such as soup, chili, flour, sugar, cereal, coffee, tea, etc.

Toiletries including soap, detergent, toilet paper, deodorant, etc.

Pet food – kibble, canned.

Cash.

The Roberts cannot accept empty alcohol bottles and cans but these items can be donated at the following locations:
